- I must have a **core GPA ≥ 3.19** , an **elective GPA ≥ 3.0** , and a **GPA ≥ 3.0** in my program to graduate.
- Up to three graduate courses may be repeated. However, no graduate course may be repeated more than once.
- I must make up any **incomplete (I)** grades by the deadline or it will turn into an **F** on my transcript.
- I know I must be in the correct program (**CS** or **SE**) at least two (2) semesters before graduation.
- I know that missing three or more lectures in the beginning of any semester may result in dropping one letter grade; missing 4 or more lectures may result in a failing grade.
- I know I **cannot** enroll in classes while on Academic Probation until the current Semester grades are posted and I have written permission from the Director of Graduate Studies.
